



HWHP EMT Challenge Awards Criteria



Membership with **Holland Western Horse Park (HWHP)** makes you eligible for great prizes! HWHP members accumulate scores toward Daily High Score and Year End High Point prizes. *While EMT Challenges also count for points with the **Premier Mount N Trail Association (PMT)**, note that riders are **not** required to become members of PMT in order to be eligible for prizes offered by HWHP.

Class Placings (All Participants)

Each horse/rider combination will receive a score from the PMT-Certified judge in each class and be placed per Premier Mount N Trail Association (PMT) Rules. 1st-6th place will be awarded ribbons. Judges' decisions are final. There is **no** membership requirement for earning class placings at Challenges.

Challenge (Daily) Awards (HWHP Members)

In addition to individual class placings, the **1st-3rd** highest scoring horse/rider combinations in any individual pattern, In-Hand or Riding, within each of the 7 categories below will be awarded at each Challenge:

Rookie or Green Partnership
Level 1 Youth, Adult, or Open
Level 2 Youth, Adult, or Open
Level 3 Youth, Adult, or Open
Level 4 Youth, Adult, or Open
Small Equine
Junior Horse

Year End Awards (HWHP Members)

Year End High Point prizes will be awarded for the **1st-3rd** highest scoring horse/rider combinations over the course of the season, within each of the 22 Division & Level Combinations offered:

Riders must meet the following criteria to be considered eligible for the Year End awards:

- Riders start accumulating scores toward Year End awards at the time they become members in good standing of Holland Western Horse Park.
- Riders must compete in at least 4 out of the 7 Challenges to qualify for Year End awards. (The August 11 Challenge is double-points and counts as 2 separate Challenges for meeting this criteria).
- A rider's 6 highest scores in each class will be used in determining their overall series score for Year End.

*Although not required for HWHP awards, PMT membership is \$30 for youth/\$40 for adults and qualifies riders for their separate year end awards structure, in addition to HWHP awards. PMT membership also includes other perks such as automatic Ohio Quarter Horse Association membership with qualification for OHQA's points and awards, and a RIDE program that offers prizes for horsemanship and volunteer hours logged throughout the year.
